# **RULES & REGULATIONS OF ENTRY**

#### No Birds at show this year due to Avian Flu regulations

- 1. Fees £2.00 per entry for birds and £1.00 per entry for eggs.
- 2. Exhibits must be penned by 9.30 on Show Day. Please note that vehicles must be removed from the showground by 9.00am as the gate will be locked between 9.00am and 5pm. Judging to commence at 9.45am.
- 3. The Committee will make careful arrangements for the safety of the birds but will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may happen to them during the show.
- 4. Classes with small entries may be amalgamated within the breed or colour.
- 5. Classes with excessive entries may be split between male and female.
- 6. No bird can be boxed until 4.30pm on the day of the show.
- 7. Exhibitors paying £6 for entries will receive one ticket of admission to the Show. Exhibitors paying £10 for entries will receive two tickets to the show.
- 8. Cancellation Policy The Society reserves the right to postpone, cancel, abandon, or curtail the Show due to force majeure or otherwise at its absolute discretion. In no circumstances shall the Society be liable, in contract, tort (including negligence or breach of statutory duty) or otherwise howsoever, and whatsoever the cause thereof (i) for any loss of profit, business, contracts, revenues, or anticipated savings, or (ii) for any special indirect or consequential damage or losses of any nature whatsoever. For the purposes of this Condition, 'Force Majeure' means fire, explosion, flood, lightning, Act of God, act of terrorism, war, rebellion, riot, sabotage, or official strike or similar official labour dispute, or events or circumstances outside the reasonable control of the Society.
- 9. All exhibitors must have a valid CPH number unless you have one you will not be allowed to enter birds.
- 10. Exhibitors are to make themselves aware of the regulations and the current Protection Zones in place by visiting

We are unable to accept entries from within any current **Protection Zone.** 

- Birds should be health checked before travelling to the show; and that any birds travelling from the show
  to any premises whether they are returning home or to a new location, must be isolated from other birds
  and health-monitored for at least one week.
- Any exhibitor wishing to sell birds after showing **MUST** go through the poultry section leader where names and addresses **MUST** be recorded.
- Poultry arriving at the show will be individually inspected before being allowed into the Marquee. This should only take a few minutes to complete.
- All carriers must be clean and in good condition, any found not to be upon inspection the exhibitor will be refused entry and asked to leave the showground.
- Any poultry that fail the inspection or show any signs suggestive of avian notifiable disease during the event will be reported immediately to APHA.
- Please bring the declaration that **you must complete** with you when you present your birds for inspection, before entering the Poultry Marquee.
- Due to the need to inspect every bird before entering the Marquee, we recommend your earliest arrival on show day.

We trust you will appreciate the need for these additional bio-security measures and that they are there to protect everyone's interests and the birds'. We thank you in anticipation of your patience and co-operation with this important matter and look forward to welcoming you to Ashbourne Show .

11 The Society's Veterinary Officers are authorised to refuse permission for any animal or bird to be admitted to, or to have removed from, the Showground any animals affected with contagious or infectious disease, or any deemed not fit to show. Concealment of disease will render the Exhibitor liable to disqualification.

Exhibitors should not bring any diseased or ill animal or bird onto the Show premises, and if under any circumstances this regulation be violated, the exhibitor of the animal or bird will be solely responsible for any claims that may arise for damage or loss to other exhibitors or any other persons, and the Society holds itself free from liability in such cases. Should any animal or bird manifest symptoms of disease or illness during the Show, it must be reported to the Chief Steward of the relevant Section immediately.

The Society has an appointed veterinary surgeon and their role is to deal with requests from judges, stewards and other Society officials and to attend to emergencies that may arise. It is a condition of entry that these veterinary surgeons may on their own authority give to any animal such emergency treatment as they may consider appropriate in the event that the owner or their representative cannot immediately be found. Exhibitors will be required to pay any such veterinary surgeon for the full cost of the treatment administered whether in an emergency as above or if such treatment is requested.

#### **Personal Information Consent**

In order to provide a professional and effective service to competitors and entrants to Ashbourne Show, we need to keep a record of personal information. This is information such as your name, contact details and age (under 16's), and possibly those of family members if appropriate.

The Ashbourne Shire Horse Society respects your privacy and will only use your data for the provision, communication and processing of your entry and other requirements and for providing you with information regarding future Shows and events. Entrants' information may be published within a show catalogue, and provided to the relevant breed societies and professional and regulatory bodies as necessary and prize-winners may be listed on our website and elsewhere.

We will not otherwise share your personal data with other third parties without your prior consent unless required to do so by law. All personal information is treated as private and confidential; it is recorded electronically on a database and/or in a paper file.
